Power Generation Facility, Boston, USA

A 1600-megawatt (MW) natural gas-fired combined-cycle electric power generating facility near Boston. The new facility, which incorporates state-of-the-art "G" combustion turbine technology manufactured by Mitsubishi Heavy Industries (MHI), will be supplied with natural gas from a 20-inch diameter pipeline to the nearby liquefied natural gas (LNG) terminal. The generation equipment comprises four combustion turbines, four heat recovery steam generators (HRSGs), and two steam turbines configured in two identical power blocks each comprising two combustion turbines and one steam turbine.
